



SLS Cement Hill is Alive!

Cement Hill, located in the southern suburb of Seacliff Park, is operated by Surf Lifesaving South Australia. In the past few years Air-Stream has been developing a relationship with SLSA to aid the development of a communication system for SLSA while expanding the Air-Stream network at the same time. Cement Hill has been one of the 'core' nodes of this project which will allow the further expansion of the Air-Stream network well into the South of the Adelaide Metropolitan area. After many weeks of planning and negotiations with SLSA we have finally completed the first stage of the Cement Hill build which brings the node onto the network and allows for much greater access for many people not only in the South of Adelaide but many nodes in the West too! On the 2nd and 3rd of January Sam, Sam, Nathan, Justin, Drew, James, Tom, Troy, Michael and a few others braced the extreme 40c+ heat to complete this project. The first stages were strengthening the mast, as the old triangular mast was only secured by a stobie pole. This was achieved using a new device which has not been used before. The 'anchor' points were secured using 'Ancor-Locs' which are driven into the ground and when pulled up swivel 90 degrees and 'lock' into the ground. Two sets of Guide--Wires were then used to lock the mast into place, wireless gear was then installed and connected with the first backbone connecting to Highgate-Park-SW Sector. Cement Hill has 2x 2.4Ghz sectors and 2x 5GHz sectors which one of each pointing North and South. Thanks to all the guys who put in the hard work to complete this site and if you are in the south or west, go get stumbling!

With the initiation of Peering Agreements, Host Site Agreements and Job Safety and Environmental Analysis sheets enter into the picture Air-Stream took a big step forward into making a much more professional image to businesses and members alike looking to participate in the great network we have! Our first Peering agreement was signed with the Lutheran Church of Australia in cooperation with Lutheran Community Care as well as our first official Host Site Agreement with Carrick Hill! Network Updates

Seaton 2

Seaton 2's mast was finally raised to full height that it once was 18 months ago, Nathan, Tom, Troy, Shawn, Sam and Sam all attended to fix the guide wires and re-raise the mast safely. Seaton 2 is connected to Sefton Park presently and will look to potentially connect to Cement Hill and Port Adelaide again in the future.

Para Hills 6

Para Hills 6 has been connected to Modbury North since its installation, it was never ment to be possible with all Line Of Site plots showing it was passing through the top of a hill, however due to the close proximity of the sites it was attempted with success. However in recent months a house is believed to have been built between the sites and the link became unusable. The hardware at Modbury North was then relocated to Parafield Gardens 4 and the dish at Para Hills 6 was rotated and aligned there. Presently the link is performing at around 15mbit throughput and is stable which is a fantastic improvement over the previous link to Modbury North.

Inglefarm

Due to the recent extreme heat some sites have been experiencing stability issues, Inglefarm has been one of them, the current research has identified a potential issue with the UPS which powers the site, this is planned to be decommissioned to identify if this was the issue.

GSPV

Following on from sites being effected by the heat, the GSPV-IngleFarm Ubiquiti Nanobridge has also been spontaneously restarting during the peak heat, a replacement has been ordered and will be swapped at the first available opportunity.

Upcoming Projects

Suntrix-Hermitage is a new build in Lower Hermitage, this will provide amazing connectivity between EARC and Modbury North.

EARC upgrade project is well into the planning stages with a proposal to be submitted at the end of January.

LHI-LCC-Glynde has passed the planning stage and is awaiting hardware to arrive for installation.

Various southern nodes will now have the opportunity to connect thanks to the Cement Hill completion, so expect a big expansion down south!


